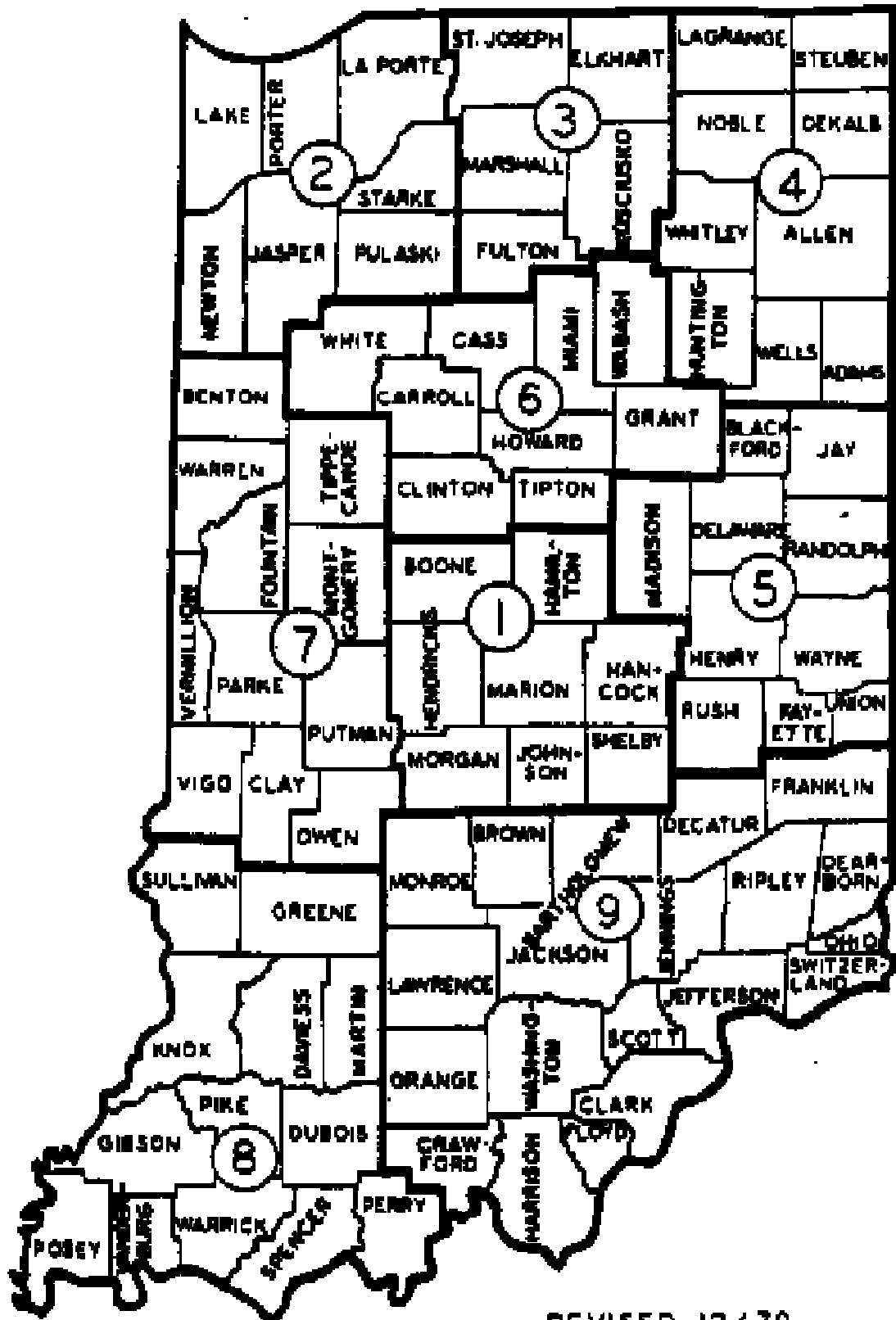


The following historical information was compiled by Indiana Bowling Association Hall-of-Famer Tom Tobin. It is being placed here in his honor and memory.
